

## **CASUAL Deck Hand**

### **I. POSITION SUMMARY**

This position is a casual marine position which includes upkeep of all vessels and related equipment in accordance with the Captain's and/or Pilot's, Boatswain's instructions. Most job responsibilities require little or no previous skills. Required to hose, buff, swab, sweep, and scrub the vessel as well as monitor passenger access/egress areas for safety and integrity. This position is required to work safely and efficiently in accordance with instructions, general operating practices, and procedures. Work is focused on immediate unit with limited awareness of related areas. Work schedules can be modified to fit the departmental needs which may require the employee to work shift work and/or weekends. Work is performed indoors/outdoors and can be in any weather condition. This casual position is part-time with no guaranteed minimum number of hours, nor are there any guaranteed assignments.

### **I. ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Assist passengers in making their transit safe and enjoyable
- Demonstrate the use of safety equipment as required
- Monitor passenger access/egress areas for safety and integrity
- Maintain vessel cleanliness
- Maintain a proper lookout
- Conduct Watchman tour
- Monitor AV/PA equipment for quality, volume and clarity
- Shore side duties for maintenance
- Could include nightshift

### **III. REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES**

- Handling mooring and heaving lines
- Ability to traverse inclined and vertical ramps and ladders
- Confidence and ability to work with and around rotating machinery ,and close to the water's edge
- Possess excellent customer service skills

### **IV. TYPICAL WORK ENVIRONMENTS**

- Deck, voids and bulwarks of vessels
- Maintenance Yard

### **V. LICENSES, REGISTRATIONS, AND/OR CERTIFICATES**

- Valid driver's license
- Ability to obtain TWIC (Transportation Worker Identification Card) fees reimbursed after receipt
- Ability to obtain MMC (Merchant Mariners Credential) endorsed as Ordinary Seaman reimbursed after 30 days worked

### **VI. REQUIRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE**

- Must be at least 18 years old
- High school diploma or equivalent or equivalent related experience

### **VII. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Subject to a background investigation
- Subject to a pre-employment physical and regulatory drug testing
