I. POSITION SUMMARY

The EHS Co-Op Intern is responsible for assisting the EHS Department in all aspects of the Environmental Program at the DRBA. This will include inspections related to Stormwater Pollution Prevention, Spill Control and Countermeasures, Universal and Hazardous Waste (RCRA) tracking, handling, and disposal, along with reviewing existing SDS information and chemical inventory. The intern will also assist in data transfer to new EHS software program as well as support planning of the DRBA World Environment Day event. The ideal candidate is a college student currently working toward a degree in environmental engineering /science. This position will require at least 25 hours per week but no more than 40 and will last for six (6) months.
