4. Bid Opening

• CMLF-24-02 Cape May Terminal Facilities Bathroom Renovations

A public bid opening was held on May 15, 2024, in which (4) bids were submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$328,000.00 to Kavi Construction, LLC of Berlin, NJ.

• CMLF-L24-03 Lewes Terminal Patio Improvements

A public bid opening was held on May 07, 2024, in which (1) bid was submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$680,848.00 to Ocean Construction, LLC of Williamstown, NJ.

• DMB-24-16 Resuflor Shop Floor DB Installation

A public bid opening was held on May 30, 2024, in which (2) bids were submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$90,280.00, to Champion Painting Specialty Services Corporation of Ft Lauderdale, FL.

Committee Chair Ratchford called for a motion to accept the bid, to which Commissioner Becker made a motion, seconded by Committee Vice-Chair Ransome and Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation to accept and authorize the action to be presented to the full Board of Commissioners later today.

• DMB-24-50 Authority-Wide Fire Suppression and Extinguisher Maintenance, Testing and Inspection

A public bid opening was held on May 22, 2024, in which (1) bid was submitted.

The COO recommended rejecting the contract, in the amount of \$96,810.00, to Wayman Fire Protection, of Wilmington, DE 19804.

Committee Chair Ratchford called for a motion to reject the bid, to which Commissioner Becker made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McCann and Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation to reject and authorize the action to be presented to the full Board of Commissioners later today.

• ILG-22-17R Dassault Fence Improvements

A public bid opening was held on May 30, 2024, in which (1) bid was submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$727,280.00 to Pro Max Fence Systems, LLC of Reading, PA.

• ILG-24-B Terminal Hold Room Expansion

A public bid opening was held on May 30, 2024, in which (2) bids were submitted.

The COO recommended rejecting the contract, in the amount of \$7,124,970.00 to Bancroft Construction Company of Wilmington, DE.

Committee Chair Ratchford called for a motion to reject the bid, to which Commissioner Becker made a motion, seconded by Committee Vice-Chair Ransome and Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation to reject and authorize the action to be presented to the full Board of Commissioners later today.

• MIV-22-08 Building M-112 Roof and Building Repairs

A public bid opening was held on April 23, 2024, in which (4) bids were submitted.

MIV is an airport where the owner is debating renewing the airport lease. Therefore, the CFO recommended restructuring this bid in the form of a base bid for the roof work and an alternate for the building envelope work.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, for the base bid only, in the amount of \$231,000.00, to Detwiler Roofing of East Earl, PA.

Committee Chair Ratchford called for a motion to accept the bid, to which Commissioner McCann made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Becker and Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation to accept and authorize the action to be presented to the full Board of Commissioners later today.

• MIV-24-B Rehabilitate Taxiway A - Phase 3

A public bid opening was held on May 23, 2024, in which (1) bid was submitted.

The COO recommended awarding the contract, in the amount of \$2,144,613.50 to South State, Inc. of Bridgeton, NJ.

Committee Chair Ratchford called for a motion to accept the bid, to which Commissioner Becker made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McCann and Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation to accept and authorize the action to be presented to the full Board of Commissioners later today.

5. Project Close-outs

• CMLF-C23-09 Maintenance Dredging at Cape May Terminal

The COO recommended close-out of the contract and final payment to Barnegat Bay Dredging, Inc. of Harvey Cedars, NJ with a final contract amount of \$296,248.80.

Committee Chair Ratchford called for a motion to approve the closeout, to which Commissioner Becker made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McCann and the Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation and authorized the close-out action to be presented to the full Board for consideration at the meeting later today.

• DMB-21-08 Lane Signal Indicators Replacement

The COO recommended close-out of the contract and final payment to McLean Construction Company of Glen Burnie, MD with a final contract amount of \$1,218,600.00.

Committee Chair Ratchford called for a motion to approve the closeout, to which Commissioner Becker made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McCann and the Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation and authorized the close-out action to be presented to the full Board for consideration at the meeting later today.

• DMB-19-28 Tower and Anchorage Emergency Lighting

The COO recommended close-out of the contract and final payment to JJD Electric LLC of Paulsboro, NJ with a final contract amount of \$808,778.94.

Committee Chair Ratchford called for a motion to approve the closeout, to which Commissioner Becker made a motion, seconded by Commissioner McCann and the Projects Committee concurred with the recommendation and authorized the close-out action to be presented to the full Board for consideration at the meeting later today.
