NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Director is hereby authorized to finalize the terms and conditions of the Lease Agreement with Enterprise Leasing Company of Philadelphia, LLC. d/b/a Alamo Rent A Car, Enterprise Rent-A-Car and National Car Rental with the advice and consent of counsel, to have such Agreement executed by the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, and the Executive Director.

## **Background for Resolution:**

The Delaware River and Bay Authority operates the Wilmington Airport. Enterprise currently operates a leasing facility within 1 mile of the airport. They have a demand for pick-up and drop-off service for rental cars at the airport, but the demand currently does not necessitate the need for an on-airfield operation. This will be a pickup and drop-off service for rentals already booked. The airport will receive 10% of the gross receipts for all activities linked to the airport.
