Avelo Airlines Announces Two New Nonstop Routes at Philadelphia's Wilmington Airport: Jacksonville, Fla. and Raleigh-Durham, N.C.

Affordable one-way fares from ILG start at \$39 Avelo now serves 14 destinations from ILG

PHILADELPHIA and WILMINGTON, Del.; March 11, 2025 — Avelo Airlines announced today it will expand service at Philadelphia's Wilmington Airport (ILG) with nonstop routes to Northeast Florida's Jacksonville International Airport (JAX) and North Carolina's Research Triangle via Raleigh-Durham International Airport (RDU). Avelo is the only airline offering nonstop service between ILG and these two destinations.

Beginning in May, Avelo will operate these routes twice weekly, utilizing Boeing Next-Generation 737 aircraft. Affordable one-way fares start at \$39*. Travelers can make reservations at AveloAir.com.
